

Bastrop FFA Graduation Cord & Letterman Jacket Policy

Revised on 07/6/21

Article I. This policy dictates the requirements for students to earn the privilege of qualifying for their letterman jacket, graduation cord, and stole.

Article II. Letterman Jacket

Section A. All letterman jacket candidates must have received their Bastrop FFA Chapter Degree and meet one other of the following criteria.

- i. Banner at an Area LDE, SDE or CDE contest.
- ii. Receive their Texas FFA Lonestar Degree.
- iii. Completed 2 years as a chapter officer.
- iv. Obtained a District, Area, or State Office.

Section B. All costs associated with the jacket are covered by the student.

Article III. Graduation Cord - Blue and Gold

Section A. In order to obtain the Blue and Gold graduation cord, students must have received their Bastrop FFA Chapter Degree .

Section B. In addition members must have participated in a district or higher competitive FFA event.

Section C. Also, members must submit a request form by date set by advisors.

Section D. The cost will be covered by the chapter.

Article IV. Graduation Stole

Section A. In order to obtain the graduation stole, members must qualify for the Blue and Gold graduation cord as well as one of the following criteria:

- i. Complete year of service as a Bastrop FFA officer.
- ii. Receive the Texas FFA Lonestar or the National FFA Degree.

iii. Qualify for a state competitive FFA event; this criteria can be met by making sale at a major (state) show.

Section B. Members must submit the request form by date set by the advisors.

Section C. The cost will be covered by the chapter.
